
DialaRide Buses Get a Tattoo Makeover

This was an ideal opportunity to redesign the livery. This local charity, which has been serving the community for over 30 years, feels very strongly about sourcing things from the local area and supporting local talent. The new buses were purchased from Marks Transport and the logos were applied by Allen Signs, with the new livery designed by Bethan Liente a local tattoo artist and graphic designer.
