

A46 Roundabout Construction Update

Date of Update: 19th August 2020

Works to improve the A46 near Dunholme and Welton are progressing well and the 24/7 closure of the A46 between the Welton and Dunholme turn-offs is set to end on Wednesday 2nd September.

However, there is still a lot of work to do as part of our plans to make this important stretch of road safer for everyone who uses it; including continuing to build the new roundabout and reconstructing sections of the A46.

From Thursday 3rd September we will be making a start on rebuilding the eastern section of the A46 near Dunholme and Welton, between Lincoln Road (to Welton) and the Scothern Lane crossroads. As part of this work, the A46 will be closed overnight for four weeks, from 7pm to 6am, Monday to Friday. The diversion route during the closure will be via the A631 to the A15 to the A46 Riseholme and vice versa. A map showing this route is below.

Access for residents who live off Lincoln Road (to Dunholme) will be maintained via the Scothern crossroads and Lincoln Road (to Welton).

In addition, temporary daytime traffic signals will be in use on the A46 near Welton and Dunholme from 9.30am to 3pm, Monday to Friday, starting on Thursday 3rd September until early December.

These works will inevitably cause some further disruption, but we'll be doing our absolute best to keep traffic moving.

Over the coming months, we will also be focusing on removing and re-aligning the whole of Lincoln Road later this year, as well as reconstructing the western section of the A46 near Dunholme and Welton early next year. More details about both of these sets of works, including dates and traffic management, are still being finalised so we will be sharing all of this closer to the time.

The project is still expected to be completed next spring.
