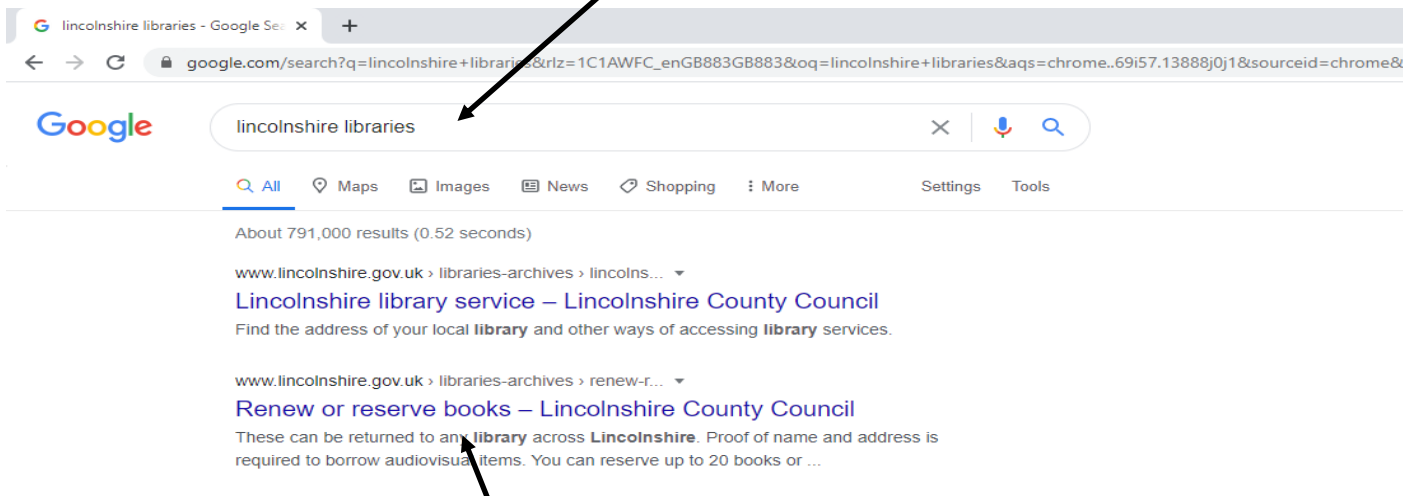


Welton Village Library—Access to member's On-line resources

A) Enter Lincolnshire Libraries in a search engine



B) Select the renew or reserve books option—this is good for no matter which service you are looking for and now click on the next link

You can reserve up to 20 books or extend the loan period for items you already have online. You will require your library card and PIN.

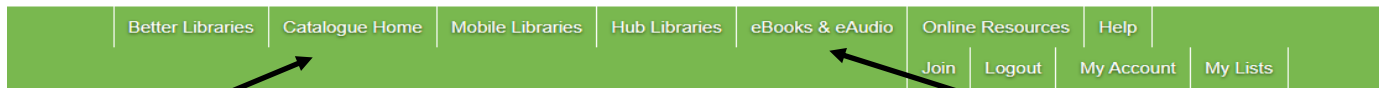
