The parish council has embarked on an exciting project to create a series of QR code boards, each of which would allow people, via their phone, to access a recording and perhaps images that tell a story relevant to that particular spot. Some locations suggest themselves very easily: the church, the village pump, the village hall and so on, but the project would also like to include more personal stories from Welton's past and present. One example might be the sad death of the Royal Observer Corps member, killed in the crash of a German plane on Hackthorn Road, but it doesn't need to be tragic: maybe you know of something really funny that happened or that just makes an interesting story that brings to life something about the life of Welton and its residents.
