### Fireworks: the law

With Guy Fawkes night coming next month, a gentle reminder of the law relating to fireworks.

You cannot purchase 'adult' fireworks if you are under 18. Adult fireworks are those in categories 2 and 3 and don't include things like party poppers.

It is against the law for anyone to set off fireworks between 11pm and 7am except on bonfire night (when the cut-off is midnight) and New Year's Eve, Diwali and Chinese New Year (when the cut-off is 1am). You must not set off or throw fireworks, including sparklers, in the street or other public place.

If you are planning a party and intend to set off fireworks, please be courteous to your neighbours and let them know; particularly if they are elderly or have young children or pets that may be frightened by the noise.
